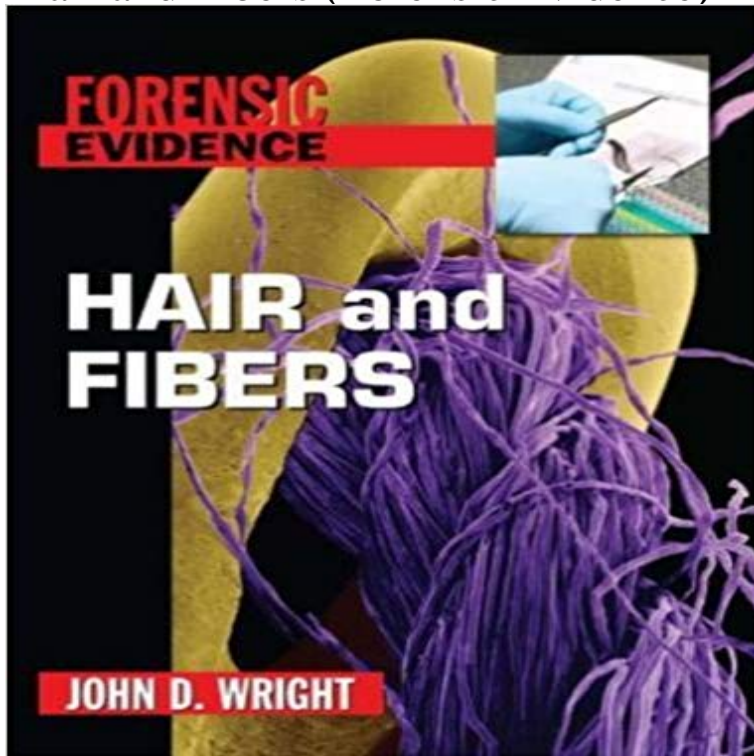


Hair and Fibers (Forensic Evidence)
